






Children help the duck get to the pond by following only the d's.


































If d is heard, write **d**. If not, put an X on the picture. Pictures are doll, donut, sandwich, mouse, domino, and doctor.






Top: Count how many train engines. Color the number 2 and the engines. **Bottom:** Trace and write the 2. Use the number chart on page 55 and have the children count to 10.








